I Will Not Stop Praying

Today's media cyber warfare against Israel is at an all time high. It seems wherever one turns in any form of media, anti-Semitism is present waiting to spew its venom around the world through modern technology outlets. Hatred of the Jewish people is coming from almost every continent. Today's condemnation of Israel is yesterday's behavior also, as history "repeats itself". We live in a world of gods – gods of materialism, prosperity, worship of sports, celebrities, political figures and deities of every spirit of deception of the human imagination. It is disheartening, to say the least, when the world falls so far as to dedicate a "Flying Spaghetti" monster (FSM), which is the deity of the Church of



So it is with the spirit of anti-Semitism, which forms its own resistance to truth, when left to itself, and where God-fearing people do nothing. The spirit of Iran's fanatical Islam is against the Jewish nation. It exalts itself against Israel, just as Pharaoh did against the Hebrews. (Exodus 9:17). The deceiving spirit of Islam, which denies the God of Israel, and that Jesus is Messiah, who lived, died, rose again and promised to return, refuses to humble itself before the God of the Hebrews, even today. (Exodus 10:3) This God of the Hebrews, the One True God, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, is still on His Heavenly Throne, totally in control, and He will eventually pass judgment on all of the gods of Islam, and other false deities on the earth. As we watch history being repeated against the Jewish people, we must not be silent, but must pray more fervently and intensely than ever before. Let's Go to the Throne Room to Pray:

“...appoint watches of the inhabitants of Jerusalem everyone in his watch...” (Nehemiah 7:3, KJV).

Governments around the world seem to be divided and the lack of harmony and unity prevails in many places. Arguments, debates and outright fights are sometimes reported in the media. Israel's government,

like all others, needs to be joined together as one voice in decisions crucial to the problems they face today. Learning to merge together, fearing Almighty God and less political correctness is needed. One area where total unity is crucial is that Jerusalem can never be divided again and that it must remain the eternal capital of the State of Israel.



- **Fervently pray** for stronger alliances of combined actions in the Knesset, to be formed. Partnership with a Godly foundation in making crucial decisions is desperately needed. **“Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!” (Psalm 133, KJV).** There is an anointing upon the thoughts and actions of the hearts when unity is present. Pray that it will take place at a continually increasing rate so that the LORD can command the blessing! The Jewish people have called one another “brethren” for centuries and the Torah commands unity among the brethren. We love our Israeli government, but want to see them make unified decisions, because God will bless it.
- **Beseech the Lord** for Israeli security forces and emergency rescue volunteers to be prepared for any violent earthquake that might take place in this region. According to World Israel News, **“there are enough earthquakes around us in all senses of the word, but we live adjacent to the Syrian-African rift, and an earthquake can hit at any moment.”** Pray that Israel will be able to deal with any such incident as the Lord has warned that He will shake everything again that can be moved. **“The words “once more” indicate the removing of what can be shaken – that is, created things – so that what cannot be shaken may remain” (Hebrews 12:27, NIV).**
- **Cry unto the Lord** for Israel’s shepherds (Rabbis) to declare in unity that support for transgender people, homosexuality, lesbianism and all perverted ways is wrong! There seems to be a block upon the eyes (even around the whole world) in regard to this foul and carnal spirit that is violently prideful and stubborn in its *stand that they are right!* *Only God can awaken a deceived generation.* **“And because lawlessness will be increased, the love of many will grow cold.” (Matthew 24:12, ESV).** God totally detests and loathes in His Creation of human beings, what man has distorted and corrupted.
- **Call upon the Lord** for His continued Divine Protection upon the nation as the IDF’s military intelligence has confirmed a report that Iran has set up an underground weapons factory in Lebanon.
